- ii) Grade C (plain) in English
- iii) Grade D+ (plus) in Mathematics for Art based Courses only
- iv) Grade C (plain) in Mathematics for Science based courses only
- v) Grade C+ (plus) in the two teaching subjects.

For applicants with special needs (visual and hearing impairment)

- i) Mean Grade C (plain) at KCSE
- ii) Grade C- (minus) in English
- iii) Grade D (plain) in Mathematics for Art based courses only
- iv) Grade C- (minus) in Mathematics for Science based courses only
- v) Grade C (plain) in the two teaching subjects.

Note:

- i) Applicant who resat KCSE and attained minimum grade will be considered
- ii) P1 trained teachers are advised NOT to apply
- iii) Any degree done is not considered

ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- a) **ALL** Trainees **MUST** bring a laptop of the following minimum specifications (*Windows 11, Memory 8GB, Integrated Camera, Core i3 gen 6 and above, internal battery that can last for more than 3hrs, wireless capability, SSD 256GB*)

In addition:

- i. The laptop **must have the trainee's name permanently engraved** on it for identification purposes.
- ii. Every trainee **must bring a power extension cable** to facilitate laptop use during training sessions.
- b) For examinations all Trainees are required to bring **two (2) JK Copier reams** of A4 80gms printing papers
- c) All Trainees must bring at **least one Textbook** for their **two Teaching Subjects** (*see appendix B*)
- d) You should bring a Geometrical Set, Pens, ruler, pencils, erasers, sharpeners, spring files, 20 manilla papers, assorted permanent markers, A4 Exercise Books and a minimum of one ream of ruled foolscap.
- e) Trainees taking Biology, Chemistry and Physics should bring white polyester Laboratory coat
- f) Science and Mathematics Trainees should also bring a Scientific Calculator, graph book and SMP Advanced Tables 3rd edition.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

Duly completed Medical Examination Form - *NB: The College reserves the right to conduct its own medical examination on any trainee at any time (see attached medical form.)*

Note: Medical examination can also be done in college at a cost of Kshs. 500

You are required to have an active **MEDICAL INSURANCE COVER** incase of any medical issues treated outside the college during the period of training

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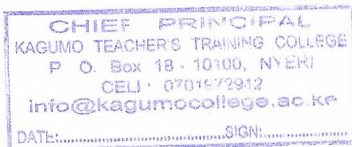
